Villa Rosa is a safe haven for single young pregnant women. The majority of the residents are in their teens, but there is no age limit. Women live at Villa Rosa free of charge. They are provided with a place to live, individual counselling, life skills, education and community follow-up.

Research has shown that the most significant predictor of future success is to stay in school. All residents at Villa Rosa are required to be in school and follow-up programs.

Villa Rosa is making a lifelong impact on women by being able to provide schooling within an environment that can also offer them a combination of counselling, care for their babies, parenting programs, as well as nutritious meals.
